The Civilian Conservation Corps was established during the great depression of the 1930s to provide employment and training to young men. Numerous CCC camps were established throughout the United States to implement the program. One of these camps, CCC Camp F-30-A, was established in Madera Canyon and was active from 1933 to 1938.
